It is important that registrations be received by the deadline so we may order materials, purchase equipment, schedule teams in league play, hire coaches and instructors, make arrangements for transportation, and secure facilities. As you can well imagine, receiving registrations after the deadline creates many problems. *A \$10 late fee will be assessed to registrations for T-Ball, Baseball & Softball activities received after deadline, except Twin Town Baseball Leagues which has a \$25 late fee.*


**Payment ...** Register online at [www.breckenridge.k12.mn.us](http://www.breckenridge.k12.mn.us) with your credit/debit card to pay for youth program fees or in person at the district office. Payment must accompany all registrations - you may write one check for the total amount of all registrations. Return the registration form with payment (checks payable to Community Education) to the District Office, 810 Beede Ave. Breckenridge MN 56520.

**Refunds ...** Refunds will be issued on an individual basis. All refunds will reflect a \$5 processing fee in addition to cost of materials and/or supplies.

**FULL refunds will be given if cancelled due to the COVID-19 restrictions or class minimums are not met.**

**Program Scholarships ...** Financial aid for qualifying residents with financial limitations are available. Contact the District Office.

**Insurance ...** Breckenridge Public School does not carry insurance for program participants other than for those participating in the Twin Town Baseball League. We suggest that you review your family's personal health insurance plan to be sure it provides you with sufficient coverage. 


