

Home Craft Kits: Indigenous Loop Earrings with Sister Beads



Learn how to create beaded earrings and collect all the necessary supplies from your local library!

Kits will be available beginning October 19 and will be available as quantities last.

You can pick up a kit by visiting the Breckenridge Library, or call 218-643-2113 to request a kit using our curbside delivery service. An instructional video will also be available on larl.org/athome.

The video is hosted by Tawny Trottier Cale, an enrolled member of the Standing Rock Sioux Tribe as well as a descendant of the Turtle Mountain Band of Chippewa and the Spirit Lake Nation. She loves to share her beadwork knowledge with others, creating custom beadwork with her sisters under the name “Sister Beads.” In the video, Tawny demonstrates how to make a pair of simple 3 loop earrings in blue, black, or purple along with the fire colors.
