All refunds will reflect a \$5 processing fee in addition to cost of materials and/or supplies. FULL refunds will be given if cancelled due to the COVID-19 restrictions or class minimums are not met.

Program Scholarships ... Financial aid for qualifying residents with financial limitations are available. Contact the District Office. Insurance ... Breckenridge Public School does not carry insurance for program participants other than for those participating in Babe Ruth Baseball. We suggest that you review your family's personal health insurance plan to be sure it provides you with sufficient coverage. The Waiver found on the registration page of this brochure must be signed by a parent or guardian.

MANDATORY COVID-19 GUIDELINES

In cooperation with the Minnesota Department of Health, following is a summary of guidelines for summer participation in the Breckenridge Youth Program. It is the recommendation of MDH that individuals with underlying health conditions not participate in group activities. Other guidelines the Breckenridge Youth Program will abide by include:

- Social Distancing at least 6 feet apart
- Pods within a program no more than 9 youth to 1 adult in a pod within that larger group
- · Parents may not be able to attend your child's activity as a spectator
- No games or large group practices are allowed to be sponsored by the Youth Program
- · There will be more specific rules/guidelines covered with participants based on individual activities
- · By registering your child, you recognize the potential risk of your child's participation in group activities during this time of COVID-19.
